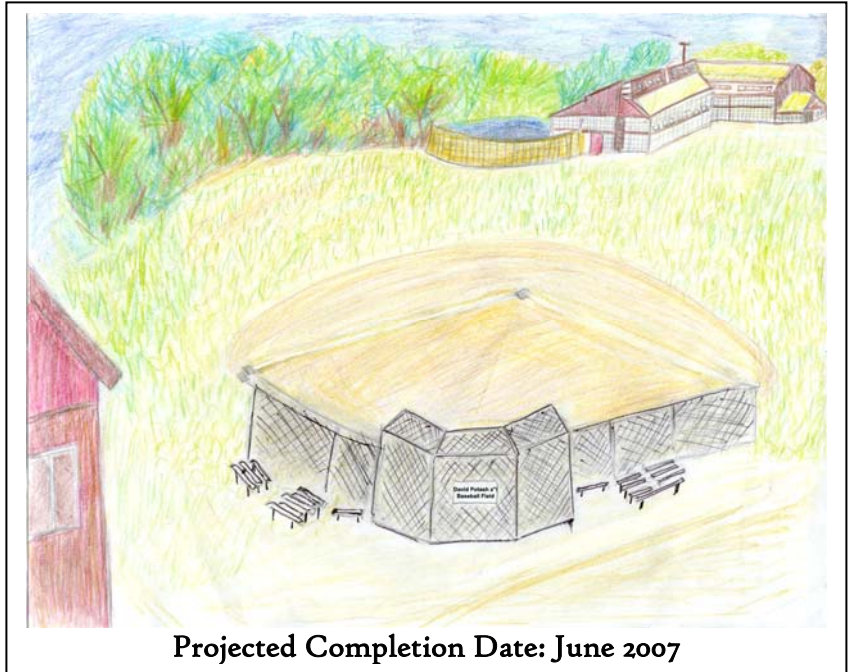


DAVID POTASH Z"l MEMORIAL BASEBALL FIELD CAMP MOSHAVA OF WILD ROSE, WI
